# Gospel Lesson-Matthew 18; John 20:19-31

Matt. 18:12 ¶ "What do you think? If a man has a hundred sheep, and one of them goes astray, does he not leave the ninety-nine and go to the mountains to seek the one that is straying?

Matt. 18:13 And if he should find it, assuredly, I say to you, he rejoices more over that sheep than over the ninety-nine that did not go astray. Matt. 18:14 Even so it is not the will of your Father who is in heaven that one of these little ones should perish.

Matt. 18:15 ¶ "Moreover if your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he hears you, you have gained your brother. Matt. 18:16 But if he will not hear, take with you one or two more, that "by the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.' Matt. 18:17 And if he refuses to hear them, tell it to the church. But if he refuses even to hear the church, let him be to you like a heathen and a tax collector

Matt. 18:18 ¶ "Assuredly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.

Matt. 18:19 ¶ "Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven. Matt. 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them."

Matt. 18:21 ¶ Then Peter came to Him and said, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? Up to seven times?"

Matt. 18:22 ¶ Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven.

John 20:19-23 Then, the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in the midst, and said to them, "Peace be with you." When He had said this, He showed them His hands and His side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord.

So Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you." And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained."
